



## COMBATING CORRUPTION AND CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

**Files**: 30 criminal cases, of which 23, started on the basis of operative information and a scheme regarding acts of systemic corruption - documented and annihilated, on acts of active corruption, passive corruption, influence peddling, abuse of office, fraud and embezzlement of foreign assets through the prism of acts of corruption.



**Subjects investigated**: head of section within the PSA, the jurist within Penitentiary no. 3 Leova (in collaboration with the National Penitentiary Administration), 1 lawyer, 20 NAFS inspectors, 2 economic agents and 4 individuals involved in acts of corruption, including 1 citizen of Ukraine.

**Domain**: public administration, finance, justice, law, public services

# **Damage established**: 7,085,800 lei, monetary means in various amounts to avoid physical and identity control of transported products

**Detentions**: 1 person detained and 1 arrested

**Finality**: 2 criminal cases submitted to the Anticorruption Prosecutor's Office with the proposal to be sent to court

### Combating corruption in the press:

- Press conference held by the Director of the National Anticorruption Center, Iulian Rusu, and the director of the Food Safety Agency, Radu Musteata
- NAFS Giurgiulesti file: Seven people were placed under house arrest and four - under judicial control
- <u>Judge</u>, referred to justice for including incomplete or false data in the declaration of assets and personal interests
- A man, detained at the beginning of the year by the NAC, was sent to court for influence peddling



- A former policeman, investigated by the NAC, referred to justice for committing two episodes of influence peddling
- The ex-president of the Anenii Noi district, referred to justice for exercising his duties in the public sector in a situation of conflict of interest



• The criminal case, initiated on the fact of the illicit enrichment of a Member of



Parliament, reached the magistrates' table

- <u>Eight searches and four officials from Hâncești</u> investigated, after allegedly claiming sums of money for the final reception of real estate, including in laloveni
- The young man, accused of robbing two girls of almost 500,000 lei, who allegedly belonged to a political group, referred to justice
- <u>Two police officers from Cahul sentenced to 5 years in prison for corruption</u> actions
- <u>Six people were detained by the NAC, in Edineţ and Donduşeni, in cases related to the bribe received for the issuance of driver's licenses</u>
- <u>Cahul Court of Appeal upheld the conclusions of the investigating judge regarding</u> the 11 employees of the National Food Safety Agency, detained in Giurgiulești
- Man sentenced to 1 year in prison for influence peddling

## CRIMINAL ASSETS RECOVERY AGENCY

**Delegations**: 62 delegations, ordered within 42 criminal cases, regarding 83 subjects and 93 delegations were executed, ordered within 57 criminal cases, regarding 145 subjects. On 30.04.2023, the Agency had 138 delegations in the procedure, ordered within 105 criminal cases regarding 209 subjects.

**Seizures**: 1 297 523 991,86 lei

Assets, management and disposal: The evaluation of 111 criminal assets (8914 immovable assets and 20 movable assets) was carried out, worth total of 34 421 294,85 MDI





At the same time, the administration was ensured of the seized funds, in cash, in national currency (MDL) and foreign currency (EUR, USD), the value of which, equated in national currency - Moldovan lei, according to the official exchange rate of the NBM, on 04/30/2023, amounts to: 205,927.05 MDL.

### Criminal Assets Recovery Agency, in the press:

- NAC synthesis: CARA applied seizures worth over 1 billion lei on assets and assets located abroad in the Bank Fraud file
- An anti-corruption and criminal asset recovery workshop hosted by the NAC on April 3-5
- CARA of NAC: assets worth 5 million lei, seized last week
- NAC synthesis: 244 million lei, previously seized by CARA and prosecutors, reached the state's treasury accounts
- CARA: seizures of assets worth over 1.6 million lei were confirmed

## LEGISLATION AND ANTI-CORRUPTION EXPERTISE

From the beginning of the year until 30.04.2023, 383 projects were approved and expertized (taking into account 11 projects remaining under examination from 2022). Of these: 169 projects were submitted for approval and the necessary recommendations were drawn up, and expert reports were drawn up on 214 projects.



Out of the total number of 214 expertized projects, 62 are draft laws, 143 draft Government decisions, one draft Parliament decision, and 8 are draft departmental acts. Following the anti-corruption expertise, the following were identified in the draft normative acts:



- 1090 risk factors (the most widespread: ambiguous wording that admits abusive interpretations (13.85%); lack/ambiguity of administrative procedures (16.15%); duties that admit abusive interpretations and derogations (10.18%); competition of norms of law (9.17%))
- 1137 corruption risks (the most widespread: abuse of office (14.78%); excess of duties (6.16%); conflict of interest and/or favoritism (11.61%); undue influence (8.18%), influence peddling (6.33%)).








#### ANALYTICAL ACTIVITY

21 operational analysis reports were developed. Out of all, in 10 cases, the operational analysis was ordered in connection with the examination of 7 criminal cases instrumented by the NAC and the Anticorruption Prosecutor's Office regarding the crimes of passive corruption and abuse of office. In another 9 cases, the operational analysis intervened in support of the investigations carried out by the NAC on alleged acts of corruption and related to corruption.

In the remaining 2 cases, the operational analysis was carried out in relation to the NAC's attributions in the area of prevention, especially the assessment of institutional integrity, etc.

71% of the prepared reports concerned the analysis of the assets owned by the persons concerned, income and sources of income, as well as personal interests in relation to the field of competence in which the subjects carried out their activity.

The operational analyzes also referred to the activity of public authorities and legal entities (10% of the total), especially the public procurement sector, as well as the analysis of relationships/connections (economic, financial, personal, etc.) between the extra persons (19%).








At the same time, the operational analyzes referred to the persons involved in the central public administration (5 reports), the field of health protection (4 reports). The areas of fiscal and customs administration (3), environmental protection (1), public procurement (1), public and private economic entities (4), etc., were also targeted.

#### ANTI-CORRUPTION EDUCATION

  training activities were carried out for about 290 people.
- Information and awareness campaign with the generic "Integrity: Credibility in the Educational System", the NAC in partnership with the Ministry of Education and Research, for managers and teaching staff of educational institutions, students and parents (municipality of Chisinau, Balti, Orhei, Anenii Noi and Rezina districts). 5 activities were carried out for about 500 people.
- NAC information and awareness raising campaign in partnership with the Moldovan Football Federation with the generic "Prevention of Manipulation of Sports Events and Fixed Bets," for the referees and players of the FC football sports club Balti. Training activities were carried out for 30 people.
- Information and awareness raising campaign with the generic "Integrity for Health" the NAC jointly with MS-CNAS-AO HOMECARE, for the medical personnel of the Health Centers (Balti, Orhei, Anenii Noi and Rezina). 4 activities were carried out for about 200 people.


